



## 2025 Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. The Fall Musky Classic is a 1 - 3 persons team event.
2. All 3 participants are required to sign the Registration Form, Waiver Form and acknowledgement of tournament rules, to compete in the tournament.
3. Only one active boat fishing, at any point during the tournament. Any combination of the 3-person team, in one boat, at any point during the tournament.
4. Shore fishing is not permitted.
5. The tournament begins at 6am October 23, 2025, and closes at 8pm October 26, 2025.
6. This is a catch, record, release event.
7. You cannot add or substitute a new teammate once the tournament has started
8. Entry fee is 150\$ entry fee per team.
9. The winning team is decided by the total length of their teams longest 3 Muskies caught over the course of the tournament.
10. There will be a 250\$ prize for the longest musky caught in the tournament.
11. For each day of the tournament (Oct 23-Oct 26) all fish caught must be submitted for review and qualification, between the hours of "6am – 10pm". Videos need to be submitted for review to "Jay Griffiths" via Facebook messenger. Please do not submit videos to the group chat.
12. A video of the measurement (using a commercially sold bump board), and a video of the release of the fish caught (until the musky swims away into the depths of the water) are required for the musky to qualify for your team. The video(s) can include both requirements in one single recording, or can be two separate videos.
13. **EACH video (measurement and release)** must include the vocalization of the "RANDOM DAILY CODE" with the fisherman's face and mouth visible for organizers to read the lips during the video.
14. Failure to vocalize the random daily code in any video will result in the fish being disqualified from your team.
15. All muskies must be live-released immediately after being measured at the point of catch in a healthy manner.

16. "RANDOM DAILY CODE" will be posted on the Fall Musky Classic website at [www.fallmuskyclassic.com/daily-code-word](http://www.fallmuskyclassic.com/daily-code-word)
17. All teams are required to have a Musky Net, Large Pliers, Hook Cutters and a Commercially sold bump board to participate in the tournament.
18. All participants must comply with their Provincial Fishing Regulations/Laws.
19. All muskies will be judged and scored to the nearest, lower quarter inch.
20. All teams must register by October 22<sup>nd</sup> , 2024
21. All entries are final, and no refunds will be issued.
22. A tiebreaker shall be decided by the team with the biggest overall fish. The lowest quarter-inch rule may be bypassed for tie breaking purposes. In the case of a further tie a coin flip (or random draw if more than 2 teams tie) will determine the winner.
23. A Breach of rules will be reviewed by tournament organizers and 1 representative from each team of participants. The final decision regarding a potential disqualification will solely rest on the tournament organizers and is thereafter non-contestable.
24. Tournament organizers have final call in any circumstances during the tournament.
25. The Tournament fees will all be put back into the tournament. Fees will cover the yearly subscription costs for the website. \$250.00 will be awarded to the participant who catches the largest musky, and the remaining money will be awarded to the winning team.
